By capturing stormwater and allowing it to seep directly into the ground, pervious concrete is instrumental in recharging groundwater and reducing stormwater runoff. Plus, pervious is listed in the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Best Management Practice manual.

Property owners can reduce fees and enhance their bottom line by using pervious concrete, which reduces the amount of labor, construction, and maintenance by eliminating the need for retention ponds, skimmers, pumps, drainage pipes, and other costly stormwater management systems.

PACA has been promoting the benefits of pervious concrete to design professionals across the state of Pennsylvania. One of the most frequent questions we get is, "Are there qualified installers for this product?"

We have made a commitment to train the industry on the installation of pervious concrete by conducting the NRMCA's Pervious Concrete Contractor Certification Course.

There are **three** levels of installation certification: **Technician**, **Installer** and **Craftsman**. ACI 522 includes language which requires personnel certified in *Pervious Concrete* to be on the installation crew at each project.

ACI 522 prerequisite :

- 5- Pervious Technicians
Or
- 3 – Pervious Installers
Or
- 1 – Pervious Craftsman

This is an opportunity to certify your crew so that you are qualified to bid on projects mandating ACI 522 compliance. **Don't forget that the *minimum* prerequisite is 5 Pervious Technicians on an installation.**

Our program consists of: 6 hours of classroom training followed by the exam and placement of pervious concrete.

Don't get caught shorthanded. Be sure you have enough trained individuals.
